



St Dunstan-in-the-West: The Giants Clock

Client: The Guild Church Council of St Dunstan

The clock pavilion was part of the mediaeval church having been added in 1671, but it was relocated to Regent's Park when the site was redeveloped and a new church built in the 1830's. In 1935 Lord Rothermere returned the pavilion to the church. The figures represent Gog and Magog strike the bells with their clubs. The grade I listed pavilion has been repaired, provided with a new copper roof, redecorated and the clock face has been re-gilded.
